


ECO DIVEMASTER COURSE

This is your chance to become a dive professional while immersing yourself to the extraordinary marine life of Raja Ampat.

INTRODUCTION

The Eco-Divemaster course offered by Papua Explorers Dive Resort is a bespoke program, combining the highest standard of PADI dive training with marine conservation. This course will develop all the skills necessary for furthering a career in professional diving, whilst improving marine ecology knowledge and providing practical scientific field experience.

Upon successful completion of the course, newly qualified divemasters may be offered a position as intern and become directly involved in our PADI 5* Dive Centre. This would include assisting the dive center managers as well as continued hands-on participation in our conservation projects. This special opportunity is offered to those passionate about diving and marine life, who are looking to make a greater commitment to improving their scuba diving skills, and gaining experience working in marine conservation projects within the Raja Ampat region.

With just few positions on offer each year, this is an exciting opportunity for the right people to fulfil a rewarding, yet demanding role, whilst immersing themselves in the waters of Raja Ampat – the most bio-diverse place on earth!

PREREQUISITES

To participate in the Eco-Divemaster program you will need to:

- be a certified Rescue Diver
- have an emergency first aid certificate (e.g. React Right) within the last two years
- have logged over 40 dives

If you are missing any of these, do not worry! We can complete all of this during your time here before beginning the Divemaster course.

Dates & Prices



This 5-week divemaster course runs between 16th June and 21st July 2024. We can take a maximum of 6 candidates who will share two water-bungalows, each with an ensuite bathroom and outside terrace.

The price is €4,500 for 5 weeks.

What is included

- PADI Divemaster training (E-Learning pack not included)
- Accommodation in a waterbungalow (shared) and wifi
- Three meals a day and snacks at our resort restaurant
- Boat transfers to and from Sorong (on normal resort transfer days)
- All marine conservation workshops and scientific dive training
